## MANAGER COMMENTARY

The UK market rose again in August, for the seventh successive calendar month. Global economic leading indicators are suggesting a slowing rate of recovery, but reopening optimism, a strong corporate results season and continuing monetary/fiscal stimulus trumped these concerns.

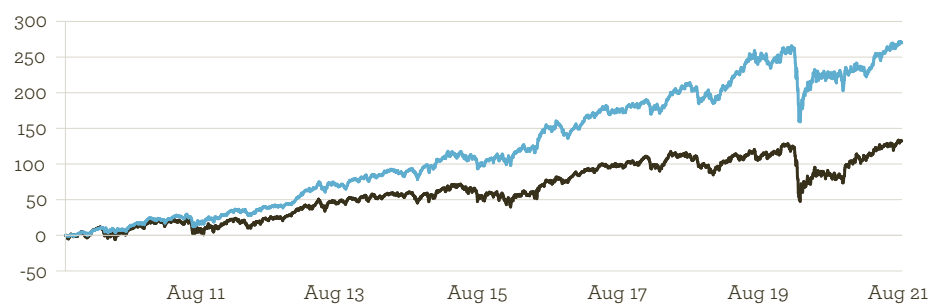
Evenlode Income rose +1.8% compared to a rise of +2.7% for the FTSE All-Share and +3.2% for the IA UK All Companies sector. The most positive contributors to return were Savills, Relx, Sage Group and Spectris. Savills released positive interim results with revenue and profit well ahead of both 2020 and pre-Covid 2019 levels. Relx, Sage Group and Spectris continued to benefit from strong results released at the end of July.

The main negative contributors to return were Hargreaves Lansdown (HL) and Smiths Group. HL released results showing continued progress, but noted that investments in the company's platform will increase in the coming year to enable current and future growth. Smiths Group announced the sale of its medical subsidiary at a lower price than market expectations (since the month end, the company has received a higher offer). This disposal will leave Smiths as a focused engineering company with strong market leadership and attractive cash generative economics.

Evenlode Income holdings have navigated through the crisis well and are now casting their eyes ahead at future opportunities. For context, the portfolio's aggregate earnings dropped -11% in 2020 and are forecast to recover by a cumulative +19% over this year and next. The dividend recovery is also underway. On 1 September, the fund went ex-dividend, declaring a second quarter rate of 1.52p per share (B Income shares) representing a rise of +15% year-on-year. Based on current forecasts, we would expect a similar growth rate for the full year distribution.

Over the last year, the fund has been somewhat 'stuck in the forgotten middle' from a performance perspective as investors have focused on deep recovery stocks on the one hand and very high-growth companies on the other. However, we are reassured by the balance of quality and valuation appeal in the portfolio. As we look ahead, we think the underlying holdings offer good potential for steady, compounding cash flow and dividend growth as the world emerges from the pandemic.

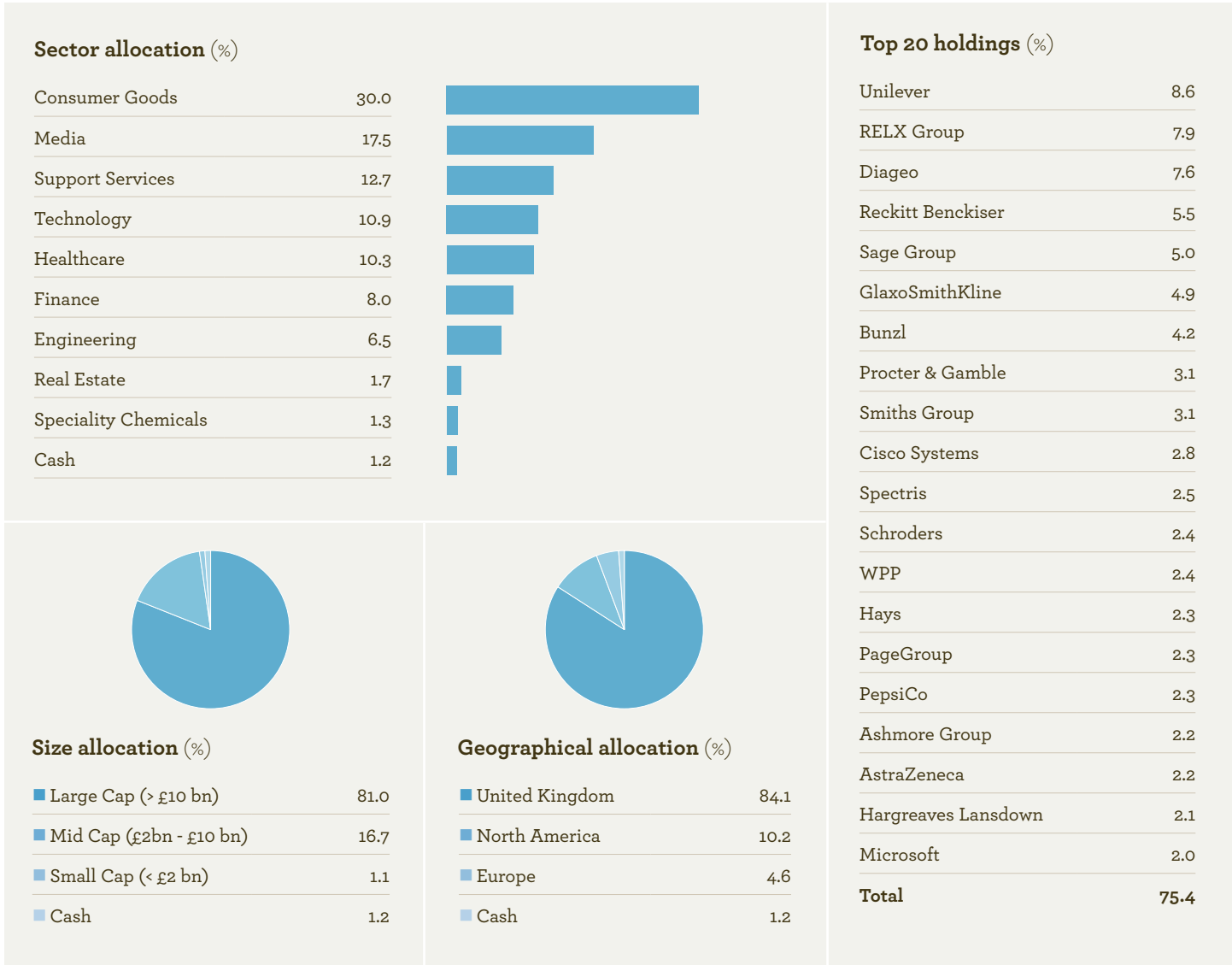

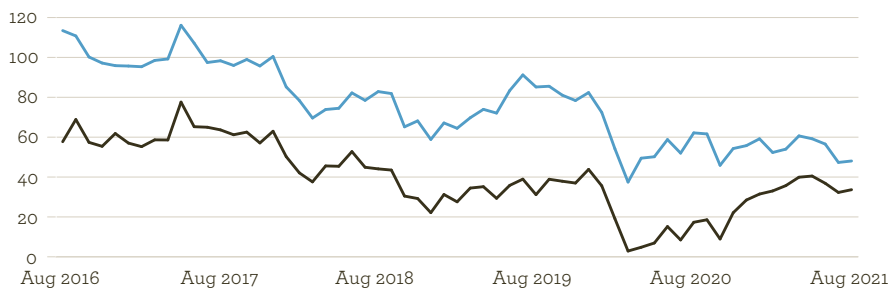

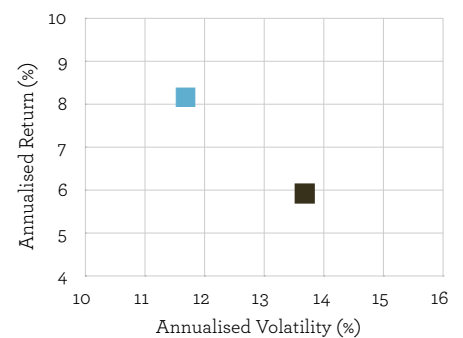


ROLLING 5 YEAR PERFORMANCE (%)

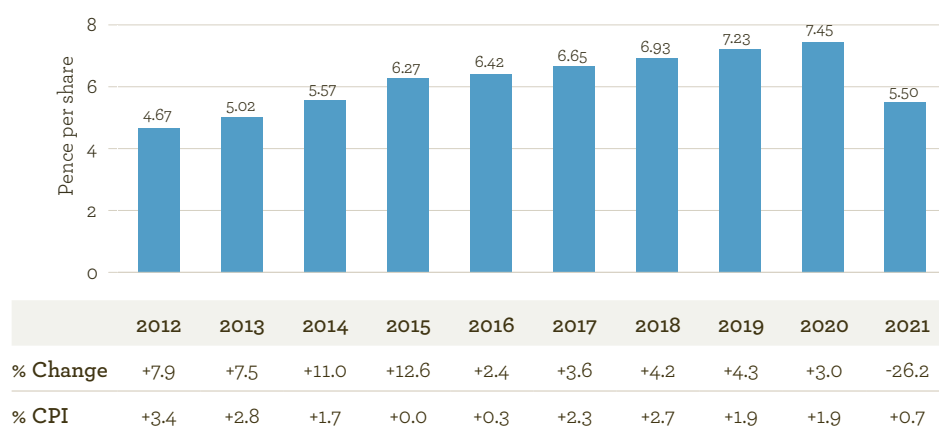
