MANAGER COMMENTARY

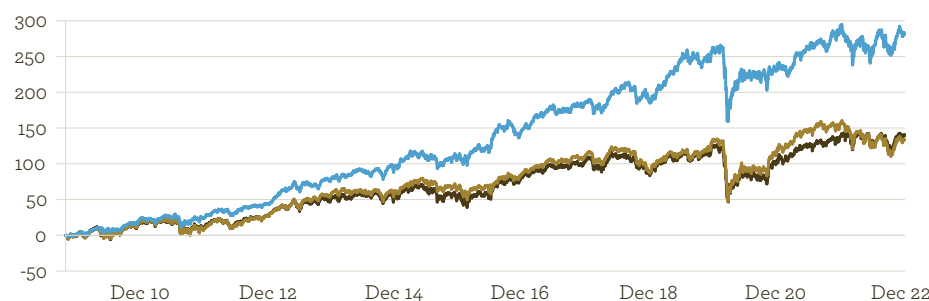
After two strong months in October and November, the UK market drifted lower in December in a quiet month for fundamental news flow. Evenlode Income fell -1.1% compared to a fall of -1.2% for the IA UK Companies sector and -1.4% for the FTSE All-Share.

The strongest contributors to return were Games Workshop, Unilever and Ashmore. Games Workshop announced a new partnership with Amazon for films and/or TV series of the company's Warhammer 40,000 franchise. Unilever held an investor event in December highlighting an increased focus on investing for growth. Ashmore's share price rose on no specific news. The most negative contributors were Bunzl, Diageo and LSE. Bunzl released a pre-close statement in December highlighting better than expected profit margins in 2022 and a decrease towards historical levels in 2023, consistent with previous guidance. Diageo's share price fell on no specific news. LSE announced a strategic partnership with Microsoft for cloud infrastructure solutions expected to increase revenue growth, but resulted in incremental costs during implementation.

The main change to the portfolio over recent weeks has been the re-introduction of a small position in Halma, with the company's share price fall in 2022 leaving our estimate of the stock's forward cash return more attractive. Halma is an engineering business with leading positions in niche, growing markets underpinned by tightening regulatory and safety standards. More generally, over the last year, falls in the share prices of several high-quality companies in the fund's investable universe (Experian, LVMH, Games Workshop, Diploma and Integrafín - as well as Halma) have given us the opportunity to further diversify and enhance the cash compounding nature of the portfolio without diluting the dividend and valuation appeal.

For the year as a whole, Evenlode Income fell -2.8% compared to a fall of -9.1% for the IA UK All Companies sector and a rise of +0.3% for the FTSE All-Share (over the last five years, the fund has returned +32.1% compared to +8.8% for the IA UK All Companies sector and +15.5% for the FTSE All-Share). We will review 2022 in more detail and discuss the 2023 outlook in the Evenlode Income January Investment View. In the meantime, it is worth noting how reassured we have been by the progress and adaptability demonstrated by underlying holdings during the volatile and operationally challenging conditions of the last five turbulent years. These market-leading companies enjoy cash-generative economics, pricing power and good potential for compounding growth over time.

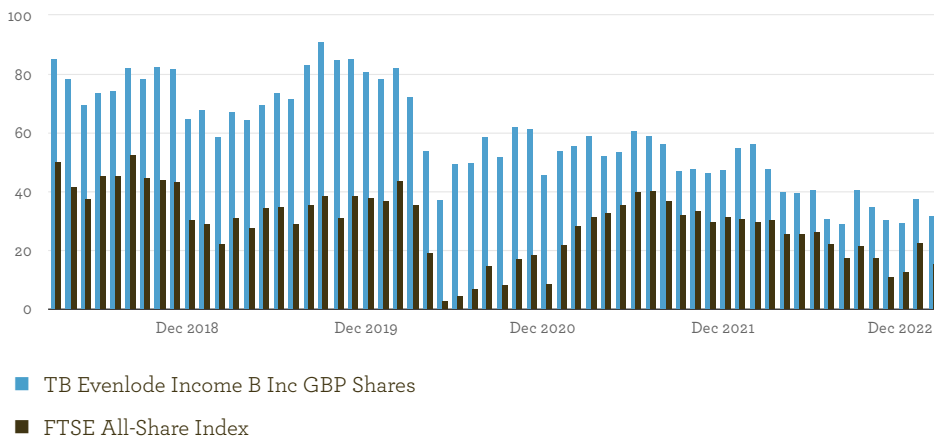

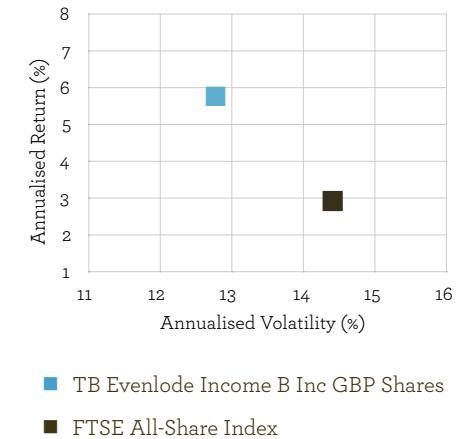


ROLLING 5 YEAR PERFORMANCE (%)

Integration into the investment process

We analyse, estimate and report on the carbon footprint of all investee companies across scope 1, 2 and 3 (subject to data availability) and aim to achieve a lower carbon footprint than the MSCI World Index. At the time of preparing the analysis at end of 2021, the results showed the emissions associated with investing £10k in one of our funds is between 0.6 and 2.4 tonnes of CO₂-equivalents, or between 25 and 56 kilograms for scope 1 and 2 alone. For context, average per-capita emissions for UK residents are 4.8 tonnes per year, or 13 tonnes per year if imports from other countries are included. This analysis further provides us with information that is the basis for risk-based targeting of company engagements.

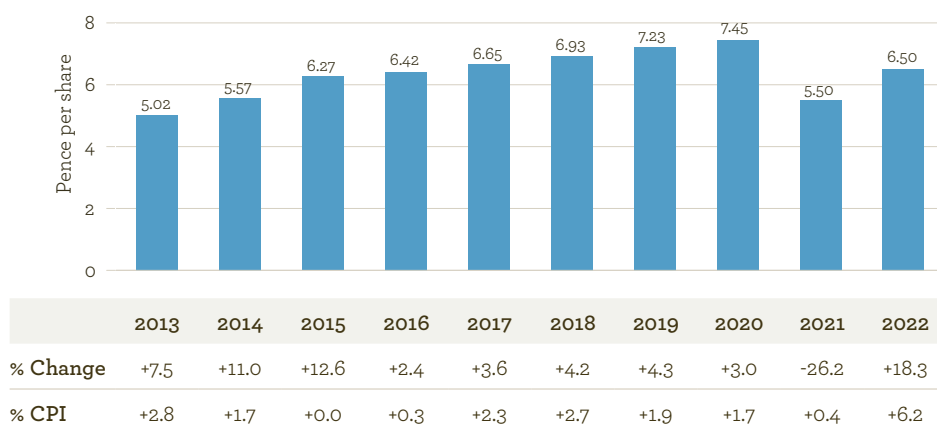
